ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BRUSH DISPOSAL SERVICE AND FEE FOR SPECIAL PICKUPS IN THE VILLAGE OF SABINA

WHEREAS, the Council of the village of Sabina seeks to provide the service of brush disposal to its residents and business owners and;

WHEREAS, said service has informally existed in the Village and;

WHEREAS, the Village seeks to improve visibility and viability of the service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina two-thirds or more of the members of the council elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The Village of Sabina Street Department shall provide a free, scheduled service for brush pickup to its residents and business owners.

Section 2: Regularly scheduled brush pickups will occur at least monthly on the 3rd Monday of every month unless otherwise publicized

Section 3: The time of the month shall be decided by the relevant department supervisor and Village Administrator and made public

Section 4: Restrictions

1. Plant material may not exceed 2 inches in diameter or 6 feet in length for a regularly scheduled pickup
2. Material must be placed near the street, but not on the street or sidewalk
3. Limbs, branches, and other woody plant material shall be stacked in as orderly manner as possible (eg branches facing the same direction) and bundled
4. This service is only for residents and business owners within the corporation limits of the Village of Sabina.

Failure to adhere to the above guidelines may, at the discretion of the Street Supervisor, result in a “no pickup” and the property owner could be subject to enforcement of any relevant ordinances.

Section 5: Village residents and business owners may obtain a “Plant Material Pickup Request” form in the Utility Office for woody material and brush that exceeds 2 inches in diameter or other reasons not specified. Said form must be filled out and returned to the Village prior to picking up brush along with a \$25 processing fee

Section 6: Approval of a special pickup will be at the sole discretion of the Street Supervisor. If approved, the resident will be contacted to notify them of the approval and the specially scheduled pickup time.
