**AN ORDINANCE AWARDING A BID TO COX ASPHALT PAVING, INC, OF 11741 STATE ROUTE 72 LEESBURG OHIO, FOR A TOTAL BID IN THE AMOUNT OF SIXTY-SEVEN THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$67,622.00) FOR GRINDING AND REPAVING OF NORTH JACKSON STREET, AND THE REPAVING OF EAST ELM STREET, IN THE VILLAGE OF SABINA**

WHEREAS, the Village Council did authorize the Village Administrator to advertise, with the assistance of McCarty Associates, for the grinding and repaving of North Jackson Street and the repaving of East Elm Street.

WHEREAS, Cox Asphalt Paving, Inc. 11741 State Route 72 Leesburg, Ohio was the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREORE, BI IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Village Administrator is directed to enter into contract for the grinding and repaving of Jackson Street, and the repaving of Elm Street.


**SECTION 2.** That the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to appropriate from the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund to pay the cost thereof.


