

Ordinance No. 2010-08 Passed January 28, 2010

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 4. of Ordinance 2009-31, establishing and setting forth users changes for the sanitary sewer system and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2009-31 effective with the regular water meter reading in January 2010 the sewer rates were to be increased.

WHEREAS, due to inclement weather and lack of staff the water meters were not read in January 2010 and the sewer rates were not increased.

WHEREAS, the village desires to change the sewer rate increase for January 2010 to become effective with the water meter reading in February 2010.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, OHIO:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance 2009-31 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
The Chares are established herein shall be effect with the regular water meter reading in **October 2009**.Charges shall be per the meter readings, on a monthly basis, and as follows:

Usage in Gallons Rate

Inside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$16.65  
Over 1,000 \$4.15/1,000

gallons

Outside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$20.00  
Over 1,000 \$5.00/1,000  
gallons

The minimum bill of \$16.65 per month will be charged for all structures with sewer availability. Any structure required to connect to the sanitary sewer system of the Village and has not done so by the date of passage of this ordinance shall be charged the minimum monthly charge.

Effective with the regular water meter reading in **February 2010 sewer rates** will be increased as follows:

Charges shall be per the meter readings, on a monthly basis, and as follows:

Usage in Gallons Rate

Inside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$21.65  
Over 1,000 \$5.38 / 1,000

gallons

Outside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$25.00  
Over 1,000 \$6.50 /1,000  
gallons

The minimum bill of \$21.65 per month will be charged for all structures with sewer availability. Any structure required to connect to the sanitary sewer system of the Village and has not done so by the date of passage of this ordinance shall be charged the minimum monthly charge.

Effective with the regular water meter reading in **January 2011** the sewer rates will be increased as follows:

Charges shall be per the meter readings, on a monthly basis, and as follows:

Usage in Gallons Rate

Inside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$24.89  
Over 1,000 \$6.19 / 1,000

gallons

Outside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$28.75  
Over 1,000 \$6.75 /1,000  
gallons

The minimum bill of \$24.89 per month will be charged for all structures with sewer availability. Any structure required to connect to the sanitary sewer system of the Village and has not done so by the date of passage of this ordinance shall be charged the minimum monthly charge.

Effective with the regular water meter reading in **January 2012** sewer rates will be increased as follows:

Charges shall be per the meter readings, on a monthly basis, and as follows:

Usage in Gallons Rate

Inside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$26.78  
Over 1,000 \$6.65 / 1,000

Gallons

Outside the Village - Minimum 0 - 1,000 \$31.00  
Over 1,000 \$7.25 /1,000  
Gallons

The minimum bill of \$26.78 per month will be chargec for all structures with sewer availability. Any structure required to connect to the sanitary sewer system of the Village and has not done so by the date of passage of this ordinance shall be charged the minimum monthly charge.

Section 2. Existing Section 4 of Ordinance 2009-31 is hereby repealed.


Section 3. In accordance with R.C 731.17 (A) (2) the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three (3) different days is dispensed with by affirmative vote of at least three-fourths (3/4) of the members of Council.



Section 4. In accordance with R.C. 731.30 this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members of Council. This Ordinance is declared as an emergency so that the sewer rates can take effect in February 2010. Therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
