

Ordinance No. 2010-12

AN ORDINANCE, to repeal Ordinance No. 2009-24, which authorized the Village Solicitor to collect overpayments from current and former village employees, based upon the State of Ohio Auditor's Findings for Recovery for audit years ending December 31, 2005-2004 and December 31, 2006

WHEREAS, the Village of Sabina, has decided to proceed in a different manner regarding the State Auditor's findings and resolve this matter.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That existing Ordinance No. 2009-24, of the Village of Sabina, Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section 2. In accordance with R.C 731.17 (A) (2) the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three (3) different days is dispensed with by affirmative vote of at least 3/4 of the members of Council.


Section 3. In accordance with R.C. 731.30 this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the Village welfare and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon affirmative vote of at least 2/3 of the members of Council. The reason for such necessity is the ordinance needs to be repealed before any further action can be taken in this matter within the allowed time frames.
