**ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH MCCARTY’S AND ASSOCIATES TO EVALUATE WILSON CREEK AND MARY’S FORK STREAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS: The Village of Sabina desires to contract with McCarty & Associates to evaluate the hydraulic flow of Wilson Creek and Mary’s Fork stream.

WHEAREAS: McCarty & Associates has informed the Village of Sabina the cost of the evaluation shall not exceed \$7,500.00.

WHEREAS: The Village of Sabina finds it necessary to conduct the evaluation of the water flow to determine the accuracy of the flood zone.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: McCarty and Associated may proceed with evaluating the hydraulic flow of Wilson Creek and Mary’s Fork stream at a price not to exceed \$7,500.00.


Section 2: This Ordinance shall be retroactive as of May 13, 2010.


Section 3: This Ordinance shall be considered an emergency measure, necessary for McCarty & Associates to proceed immediately to evaluate the creek and the stream. Such emergency exists because the work has proceeded and the Ordinance needs to be adopted for McCarty’s to proceed. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
