

Ordinance No. 2010-22

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH PART-TIME EMPLOYEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF SABINA AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Sabina finds it necessary to hire part-time employees for Village purposes;

WHEREAS, the Council allows the Mayor for the Village of Sabina, to hire part-time employees and set their hourly rate;

WHEREAS, the hourly rate will be determined by the Mayor who will consider the employees responsibilities and experience when setting said hourly rate;

WHEREAS, all part-time employees will be considered "Employees At Will" and may be terminated at the discretion of the Mayor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Mayor for the Village of Sabina is authorized to hire part-time employees to work at an hourly rate not to exceed \$16.00 per hour.

SECTION 2: Part-time employees are not entitled to Village benefits without approval of Council, except those benefits as provided by law.

SECTION 3: Part-time employees are At Will Employees, and may be terminated at the discretion of the Mayor.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be considered an emergency for the immediate public peace, health and safety of the Village. Such emergency exists because emergency situations occur during the year which requires additional personal on an emergency and temporary basis.




