

Ordinance No. 2010-26

Passed July 22, 2010.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TAXABLE BENEFIT PAYABLE TO DESIGNATED VILLAGE EMPLOYEES FOR VILLAGE BUSINESS USE OF THEIR PERSONAL CELL PHONES

WHEREAS: The Village finds that some employees of the Village of Sabina use their personal cell phones for Village purposes during work hours.

WHEREAS: Designated employees of the Village will receive an ELEVEN AND 54/100 DOLLARS (\$11.54) bi-weekly taxable benefit in their regular paycheck which will go toward the cost of using their personal cell phones for Village business.

WHEREAS: The Mayor shall determine which employees are eligible for this taxable benefit.

WHEREAS: There shall be periodic verification of the availability of the personal cell phones in the taxable benefit program as determined by the Mayor.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by Council of the Village of Sabina two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Employees of the Village as designated by the Mayor will receive an eleven and 54/100 dollar (\$11.54) bi-weekly taxable benefit in their regular paycheck which will go toward their cost of using their personal cell phones for Village business.

Section 2: The Mayor will have the authority to add or remove an employee from the approved taxable benefit list at his discretion.
