

Ordinance No. 2010-30

**AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2010, and declaring an emergency**

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Sabina during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2010, the following sum be and is hereby set aside and additionally appropriated as follows, viz:

**Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Fund 2011-620      \$40,000.00**

Section 2. And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment from any of the foregoing operations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to have the appropriation in place for paving to be done before the season ends.
