

Ordinance No. 2010- 33

Passed November 11, 2010

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN PROGRAM CODES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1.To provide for the current expenses and other expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Sabina during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2010, the following sums that were set aside and appropriated and must be transferred to other program codes within the General Fund and are hereby approved by the Council, as follows, viz:

GENERAL FUND

FROM PROGRAM	TO PROGRAM	AMOUNT
1000-930	1000-110	\$21,155.10
1000-725	1000-110	\$1,994.57

Section 2. And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment from any of the foregoing operations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3.This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the authority to expend money must be in the proper place in order to purchase a police cruiser.


