

Ordinance No. 2011-05 Passed February 24, 2011

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE WAGE PROVIDED TO JOHN B. GREHL AS A PATROLMAN OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** John B. Grehl's employment as a patrolman with the Village of Sabina shall begin at the Mayor's discretion.

**Section 2:** That the hourly compensation of John B. Grehl shall be as follows:

Probationary Wage: \$12.60 per hour  
Post-Probationary Wage: \$12.94 per hour

**Section 3:** All regulations for the probationary period shall be followed pursuant to the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.

**Section 4:** The change from Probationary Wage to Post-Probationary Wage shall be at the Mayor's discretion.

**Section 5:** This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to establish the salary and benefits provided to the Patrolman John B. Grehl at the beginning of his service to the Village.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
