

Ordinance No. 2011-7 Passed March 24, 2011.

AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING THE COST OF HEALTH INSURANCE FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA AND ABOLISHING ALL ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS IN FULL OR IN PART IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the policies of health, life and dental insurance currently provided to the employees of the Village of Sabina; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to provide such policies of insurance they determine are affordable.

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to increase the employee's share of the cost of the policies from ten percent (10%) to twenty percent (20%) effective with the pay period beginning March 27, 2011.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, TWO THIRDS OF THE ELECTED CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: By this Ordinance the Council of the Village of Sabina is authorized to provide, change or cancel such insurance as health, life, dental or other types of insurance they deem affordable or not affordable.

Section 2: Council has the discretion to determine the type of policy, provider and what level of coverage shall be offered to the employee and/or their spouse and dependants.

Section 3: The Village shall pay eighty percent (80%) and covered employees shall pay twenty-percent (20%) (through payroll withholding) of the cost of the premiums for such insurance offered to employees, effective with the pay period beginning March 27, 2011.

Section 4: All Ordinances and/or Resolutions in full or in part, in conflict herewith are hereby abolished.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
