

Ordinance No. 2011-12

Passed June 9, 2011

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA SWIMMING POOL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it would benefit the Sabina Pool financially to offer per session fees for Swimming Lessons and Tweakin the Creakin sessions for people who wish to attend fewer than the full class or entire season.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, three-fourths of all of the members elected thereto concurring, that the additional rates for the Village Swimming Pool are as follows:

SECTION 1. Swimming Lessons and Tweakin the Creakin Sessions: If a person wishes to attend some classes but not pay for the entire period of classes they may choose to pay \$5.00 per session. Per session fees cannot be applied to the full class fee at a later time.

SECTION 2: Any portion of an ordinance inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this ordinance is hereby declared void and of no effect.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall not preclude any future rate adjustments, including emergency measures, as authorized by the Council of the village, and approved by the Mayor of the village.


SECTION 9. Emergency. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency for the immediate preservation of peace, health and safety of the inhabitants in order to have the per session rates established when lessons begin. This Ordinance is effective on the date of the passage hereof.
