

Ordinance No. 2011- 21

Passed September 22, 2011

AN ORDINANCE TO TRANSFER APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN PROGRAM CODES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio, two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring, that:

Section 1. To provide for the current expenses and other expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Sabina during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2011, the following sums that were set aside and appropriated and must be transferred to other program codes within the General Fund and are hereby approved by the Council, as follows, viz:

Section 2. And the Village Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payment from any of the foregoing operations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same, or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of an in accordance with law or ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to have the appropriations in the proper place for the restructuring of employee's duties and the ability to make payroll from the proper program and fund.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately,


