

Ordinance No. 2011-22

Passed October 27, 2011

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE WAGES OF ADAM DAY, JAMES SMITHSON AND GARRETT BENTON EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, COUNTY OF CLINTON AND STATE OF OHIO, REPEALING ALL PARTS OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to increase the wages of police officers Adam Day, James Smithson and Garrett Benton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the hourly compensation levels of Adam Day, James Smithson and Garrett Benton are set for the pay period that begins on November 6, 2011 as follows:

Patrolman, Adam Day \$14.14 per hour
Patrolman, James Smithson \$13.73 per hour
Patrolman, Garrett Benton \$13.33 per hour

Section 2: This ordinance be declared an emergency measure and becomes effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure for the public, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Sabina. The reason for such emergency is to fairly compensate the officers for the work they are performing without delay so as not to lose experienced officers and interrupt Police Department operations.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately,
