AN ORDINANCE AWARDING THE PHASE II ROSE AVENUE RELIEF SEWER PROJECT TO THE LOWEST, BEST BIDDER, MELVIN ASPHALT PAVING CO., OF SABINA, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Sabina did advertise for bids for the Phase II Rose Avenue Relief Sewer project; and

WHEREAS, Melvin Asphalt Paving Co. of Sabina, Ohio was the lowest and best bid at \$435,389.95.

NOW, THEREORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor is directed to enter into contract for the Phase II, Rose Avenue Relief Sewer project with Melvin Asphalt Paving Co. for \$435,389.95.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare. The reason or such necessity is that the project authorized by this ordinance is under findings and orders of the Ohio EPA and certain deadlines exist that require immediate action. Therefore this ordinance shall go into immediate effect.
