

Ordinance No. 2012-6Passed February 23, 12, 20  

**AN ORDINANCE CORRECTING THE STARTING WAGE PROVIDED TO THE UTILITY BILLING CLERK OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Sabina, in regular session, on February 9, 2012, voted to set the starting hourly wage of the Utility Billing Clerk at \$9.50 per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Officer prepared the final draft of the Ordinance for the Mayor and President of Council's signature in error with the starting wage amount of \$9.08 per hour; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Council deem it appropriate to correct the error by confirming and setting the hourly wage of the Utility Billing Clerk at \$9.50 per hour retroactive to the first day of work by the current Utility Billing Clerk and authorizing the payment of the proper rate from her first date of work in this position.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** The starting hourly rate for the Utility Billing Clerk shall be \$9.50 per hour.

**Section 2:** The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to issue a paycheck to the current Utility Billing Clerk for the difference in hourly wage of \$9.08 per hour and \$9.50 per hour for all hours paid since the first day of work the gross amount of which is \$27.73.

**Section 3:** This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to establish correct the beginning wage for the Utility Billing Clerk and correction to the payroll can be made so service to the community can continue uninterrupted as the Council had previously determined.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
