AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2012-15, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Clinton County, Ohio:

Section One: Ordinance Number 2012-15, which states "An Ordinance Reducing the Late Payment Penalties for Water and Sewer Bills to Ten Percent of the Current Bill with The Penalties to be Proportioned Between the Water and Sewer Funds and Declaring An Emergency," is hereby repealed.

Section Three: In accordance with R.C 731.17 (A) (2) the requirement that this Ordinance be read on three (3) different days is dispensed with by affirmative vote of at least 3/4 of the members of Council.

Section Four: In accordance with R.C. 731.30 this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village and shall therefore be in full force and effect from and immediately upon affirmative vote of at least 2/3 of the members of Council. This Ordinance is declared as an emergency so that the Village may have a uniform policy for water and sewer bills.


This Ordinance shall go into immediate effect upon passage.
