

Ordinance No. 2012-18

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE WAGE PROVIDED TO OLIN MILLS AS A PATROLMAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** Olin Mills' employment as a full-time patrolman with the Village of Sabina shall begin at the Mayor's discretion.

**Section 2:** That the hourly compensation of Olin Mills shall be as follows:

Starting/Probationary Wage: \$12.92 per hour

**Section 3:** All regulations for the probationary period shall be WAIVED DUE TO PREVIOUS SERVICE.

**Section 4:** This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to establish the salary and benefits provided to Olin Mills at the beginning of his service to the Village.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
