

Ordinance No. 2013-2

Passed January 21, 2013

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE WAGES OF CHARISSA SUMMERS AND BRYAN FLOYD, EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, COUNTY OF CLINTON AND STATE OF OHIO, REPEALING ALL PARTS OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to increase the wages of employees Charissa Summers and Bryan Floyd;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the hourly compensation levels of Charissa Summers and Bryan Floyd are set for the pay period that begins on January 31, 2013 for Ms. Summers and February 13, 2013 for Mr. Floyd as follows:

Employee, Charissa Summers \$10.50 per hour
Employee, Bryan Floyd \$12.03 per hour


Section 2: This ordinance be declared an emergency measure and becomes effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure for the public, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Sabina. The reason for such is to fairly compensate the employees for the work they are performing, so as not to lose experienced employees and interrupt the Utilities Department operations.
