

Ordinance No. 2013-6

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING AND CHANGING THE SALARIES OF MAYOR AND COUNCIL

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA,
CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO:

Section One: The pay of the Members of Council shall be \$100.00 per regular
scheduled meetings.

Section Two: The pay of the President of Council shall be \$125.00 per regular
scheduled meetings.

Section Three: The salary of the Mayor of the Village shall be \$175.00 per regular
scheduled meetings.

Section Four: This shall not go into effect until the next Public Election of newly
elected officials taking office January 1, 2014. All members who are not up for re-
election at the end of 2013 will not be eligible for increase to salary, until current term
served has subsided and re-election is scheduled for the year of 2015-16.

scheduled meetings.

Section Three: The salary of the Mayor of the Village shall be \$175.00 per regular
scheduled meetings.


Section Four: This shall not go into effect until the next Public Election of newly
