

Ordinance No. 2013-19 Passed December 26th, 2013

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE #2010-40 (TEMPORARY ORDINANCE TO ALLOW THE VILLAGE POLICE OFFICERS TO WORK 12 HOUR SHIFTS AND RECEIVE OVERTIME FOR HOURS OVER 80HOURS PER PAY PERIOD) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: The Village of Sabina, Ohio desires to repeal Ordinance 2010-40 a temporary Ordinance regulating the work hours and pay of the Village Police Department.

THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Clinton County Ohio, three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

SECTION 1: Ordinance #2010-40 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance is declared an emergency measure and becomes effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure for the public, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Sabina.
