

Ordinance No. 2015-20 Passed December 23, ²⁰15

AN ORDINANCE TO RESCIND ORDINANCE 2015-18, THE AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 718 OF THE MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX ORDINANCE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village passed Ordinance 2015-18 in order to meet the requirements of House Bill 5 and the Regional Income Tax Agency, "RITA", regarding municipal income tax withholdings;

WHEREAS, RITA has requested the Village use their forms in preparing the municipal tax withholding Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the Village needs to rescind Ordinance 2015-18 and implement Ordinance 2015-20 as the new municipal income tax withholding ordinance as an emergency measure;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO WITH 3/4 OF THE MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING THAT;

Section 1: Ordinance 2015-18 is rescinded.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be declared an emergency and shall take effect immediately upon passage. The reason for the emergency is to provide for the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Sabina. Specifically, the Village needs to be in immediate compliance with HB 5.
