AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING DURING HEAVY SNOWFALL

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina, Ohio with two-thirds of all members concurring that:

Section 1: In order to facilitate the movement of traffic and protect the health, lives, safety and property of persons using streets and highways in the Village, and to combat the hazards of excessive snow and ice on said streets or portions thereof named in Section 5 of this Ordinance, when a Level I Emergency is declared by the Clinton County Sheriff's Department.

Section 2: It shall be the responsibility of the owners or operators of motor vehicles for the removal of their motor vehicles from the streets designated and to remove all motor vehicles parked in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance. The Village shall have signage posted pertaining to parking during snow emergencies and release thru available news media the declaration of such emergency and the duration thereof.

Section 3: Once this Ordinance is passed, ODOT will provide and install signs where the Village needs and wants them installed. It shall be unlawful during the period of the emergency for any person to park or cause or permit to remain parked his or her motor vehicle on those streets or portions thereof named in Section 5.

Section 4: Any motor vehicle found parked on those streets or portions thereof in Section 5 hereof during the time of such emergency may be removed by order of the Chief of Police and will be in violation of this Ordinance. In addition, if a motor vehicle is towed to a motor vehicle impound or other place for storage, the owner of said motor vehicle may recover the same only upon payment of the towing and storage charges imposed.

Section 5: Streets or portions thereof where it is prohibited after a snow emergency has been declared, during designated hours of 2AM until 6AM (hours will be posted on the signs), are the following:

- 1. North Howard Street from Washington Street to the railroad tracks
- 2. South Howard Street from Washington Street to Lewis Street

Section 6: The owner or operator of any vehicle found parked on any street named in Section 5 of this Ordinance during such a declared emergency shall be in violation of this Ordinance.
