

Ordinance No. 2016-20

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE STARTING WAGE PROVIDED TO POLICE OFFICER JOSHUA RILEY AS A PART-TIME POSITION FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** Officer Joshua Riley's employment as a part-time patrolman with the Village of Sabina shall begin with the pay period beginning October 16th, 2016 and the starting hourly rate for the part-time Police Officer position shall be \$13.50 per hour.

**Section 2:** There is no insurance benefit package offered under the part time position. There is no accrual of sick time and vacation time. No personal time is extended to the employee in this position.

**Section 3:** All regulations for the probationary period shall be followed pursuant to the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.

**Section 4:** This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to establish a beginning wage for this position so the vacancy will be filled immediately and service to the community will remain uninterrupted.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
