

Ordinance No. 2016-21Passed October 27, 2016

**AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME PATROLMAN FOR OFFICER CURTIS BROWN FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Sabina by waiving the three readings and by two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

**Section 1:** Officer Curtis Brown's employment as a full-time patrolman with the Village of Sabina shall begin with a hire date of August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

**Section 2:** The hourly compensation of Officer Curtis Brown shall start at the rate of \$13.50 per hour.

**Section 3:** The Village of Sabina full-time benefit package shall be applicable of Insurance, paid Holidays of 72 hours, Rate for worked Holiday time, Vacation time, Personal time of 24 hours, accrual of Sick time and enrollment with OP & F Pension Plan.

**Section 4:** All regulations for the probationary period shall be enforced.

**Section 5:** This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to fairly compensate the Officer at the beginning of his employment with the Village.


**Whereas, this Ordinance** shall take effect immediately upon passage.
