AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE POSITION OF FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT FOR NATHAN HAMILTON FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina by waiving the three readings and by two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Nathan Hamilton's employment as a full-time utility employee with the Village of Sabina shall begin with a hire date of April 17th, 2017.

Section 2: The hourly compensation of Nathan Hamilton shall start at the rate of \$13.00 per hour.

Section 3: The Village of Sabina full-time benefit package shall be applicable of Insurance, paid Holidays of 72 hours, Rate for worked Holiday time, Vacation time, Personal time of 24 hours, accrual of Sick time and enrollment with OPERS Pension Plan.

Section 4: All regulations for the probationary period shall be enforced.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure due to the need to fairly compensate the Employee at the beginning of his Full Time employment with the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina by waiving the three readings and by two-thirds or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Steve Carroll's employment as a full-time utility employee with the Village of Sabina shall begin with a hire date of April 24th, 2017.

Section 2: The hourly compensation of Steve Carroll shall start at the rate of \$12.00 per hour.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.


