AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IMPLEMENTING MEDICAL MUTUAL AS THE 2018 RENEWAL PROVIDER AS THE VILLAGE OF SABINA MEDICAL HEALTH INSURANCE AT A 12% RATE INCREASE.

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the policies of health insurance currently provided to the employees of the Village of Sabina; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to provide such policies of insurance they determine are affordable and the most sensible to stay with the grandfathered plan.

WHEREAS, the Council deems it necessary to retain the employee's share of the cost of the policies at twenty percent (20%) effective with the pay period beginning May 1, 2018.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, THREE-FOURTHS OF THE ELECTED CONCURRING THAT:

Section 1: By this Ordinance the Council of the Village of Sabina is authorized to provide, change or cancel such insurance as health insurance they deem affordable or not affordable.

Section 2: Council has the discretion to determine the type of policy, provider and what level of coverage shall be offered to the employee and/or their spouse and dependants.

Section 3: The Village shall pay eighty percent (80%) and covered employees shall pay twenty-percent (20%); (through the withholding of payroll) for the cost of premiums for such insurance offered to employees, effective with the pay period beginning May 1, 2018.

Section 4: All Ordinances and/or Resolutions in full or in part, in conflict herewith are hereby abolished.



Section 5: This Ordinance is deemed to be an emergency measure to implement the correct portion of withholding amount from employee wages and shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
