AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE WAGES OF OFFICER JESSE PENWELL, PATROLMAN FOR THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, CLINTON COUNTY, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to increase the wages of Officer Jesse Penwell’s hourly rate from \$13.91 per hour to \$14.92 per hour, which represents an increase of .0725%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: Officer Penwell has met and satisfied his probationary period successfully effective June 09, 2019. The new hourly compensation shall reflect his completion of the probationary level.

Section 2: This ordinance repeals prior ordinances that conflict with this pay increase for the service of Sabina Police Officers.


Section 3: This ordinance shall be declared an emergency measure and becomes prorated as of June 9th, 2019 by the passage of Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure an adequate pay scale for Officer Penwell effective on the passage of probation period for the Village of Sabina without delay so as not to lose experienced personnel and interrupt Security Operations.

Whereas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately,


