AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE WAGES OF JUSTIN ROBINSON, POLICE OFFICER OF THE VILLAGE OF SABINA, COUNTY OF CLINTON AND STATE OF OHIO, REPEALING ALL PARTS OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to increase the wages of Justin Robinson 5% at the successful completion of first year of employment with the Village of Sabina.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Sabina three-fourths or more of the members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: That the hourly compensation levels of Justin Robinson are retroactive for the pay period that began on September 15, 2019 as follows:

Police Officer: Justin Robinson \$15.67 per hour.

Section 2: This ordinance be declared an emergency measure and becomes effective upon its passage by Council and approved by the Mayor, to insure for the public, health, safety and general welfare of the residents of the Village of Sabina. The reason for such emergency is to fairly compensate the employees for the work they are performing without delay so as not to lose experienced staff and interrupt Financial operations.
