SECTION 2. PENALTY						
(a) Any minor found in violation of this section shall be deemed an Unruly Child, as defined in Chapter 2151 of the Ohio Revised Code, and subject to the penalties as described therein.						
 (b) Any parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care, custody, or supervision of said minor violating the above curfew: (1) shall receive a written warning on the first offense. (2) shall be subject to a minor misdemeanor on the second offense. 						
This Ordinance supersedes all other existing Curfew Ordinances.						
This Ordinance Shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
